

Pasadena Yacht and Country Club History and Information







Established in 1924, the Pasadena Yacht & Country Club is situated in southern Pinellas County, centrally located minutes from St. Petersburg, Treasure Island and St. Pete Beach. The clubhouse and grounds offer a peaceful, open atmosphere amid nearly 300 acres of subtropical landscaping, which is home to abundant wildlife. Boca Ciega Bay offers refreshing bay breezes and a picturesque horizon.

Pasadena Yacht and Country Club is a private club with traditional values and first-class amenities. The 18-hole Championship golf course was originally designed in the 1920's by Wayne Stiles and was renovated in the 1980's by legendary golfer Arnold Palmer. Pasadena is considered one of the top courses in this area.

The course has hosted a number of PGA and LPGA events and celebrities like Arnold Palmer, Walter Hagen, Babe Ruth, Michael Jordan, and legendary LPGA founder Babe Dedrikson Zaharias. In fact, Walter Hagen served as the first club professional during the early years of the club.
