



**TO: All FAMA members that report truck data on the statistics website**  
**RE: Statistics Website Changes**

We have experienced issues where truck reporting companies have not entered ship dates when entering truck data on the website. We assume this is caused by a company's intent to wait until the truck ships and then enter the ship date, however that task is simply missed when the truck does ship. When truck data is entered without a ship date the result is inaccurate truck ship reporting data. To avoid inaccurate ship truck data reports we have added new programming to the website.

If your company has trucks in the system that do not have a SHIP DATE, a notice will appear above the search criteria. Included in that note is a link to view those trucks. Clicking that link will take you to the search results page where you can view/update the trucks with SHIP DATES.
