SAVE AFG and SAFER, April 29-30, 2024

Hill Day 2024 is the most important Hill Day that FAMA and FEMSA have ever held. The future of the AFG and SAFER programs hang in the balance. Scheduled to sunset on October 1, 2024, the Fire Grant programs need a reauthorization to continue into the future.

We are, therefore, calling on all FAMA and FEMSA members to attend this year's Hill Day to ensure that AFG and SAFER continue to provide critical equipment and personnel to both volunteer and career fire departments across the country.

These Departments play a critical role in the nation's response strategy. They are the first on the scene of devastating storms and natural disasters, first on the scene of hazardous spills and terrorist events. And they remain on the scene until the job is done.

With our coalition partners in the Fire Service, we need to blanket Capitol Hill to demand that the reauthorization bill, which passed the Senate on a 97-2 vote and reported out of the Science Committee in the House, reaches final passage as soon as possible.

This year, Hill Day has one message: SAVE the FIRE GRANTS PROGRAMS. We need you to be part of saving AFG and SAFER.
